### Life Skills Centre

The Life Skills Centre specifically seeks to achieve this objective

by providing Maths, English and character development to teenage girls and boys in a setting outside of school. Taught through a variety of means, from individual mentoring to preparing lunch, hikes or the giving of presentations for example the vocational training takes into account the five aspects of the human person that require care and development. These include the body with the physical environment in which one lives and works, social aspects and skills, development of intelligence, cultural life, and spiritual understanding.

## National and Local Statistics

**English Achievement**—In 2013 fewer pupils in Knowsley made expected progress between Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 in English than the national average , Only **53.4%** compared to **70.1%**.nationally.

**Maths achievement**– In 2013, fewer pupils in Knowsley made expected progress between Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4 in mathematics than the national average . Only **51.6%** compared to **70.6%**. nationally .
